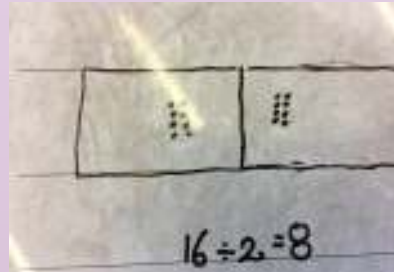


# ASPIRE WEEK IN YEAR ONE
